

LISZT INSPECTIONS

In this unique program, pianist Marino Formenti, one of today's foremost performers of contemporary music, reveals previously underappreciated and unperceived aspects of Franz Liszt's musical language. A labyrinth-like dialogue takes the listener on a dazzling and diverse journey through thirty works by thirteen composers from three centuries, elucidating the multifaceted and radical nature of Liszt's oeuvre while shedding new light on and dispelling canonical assumptions about his music.
